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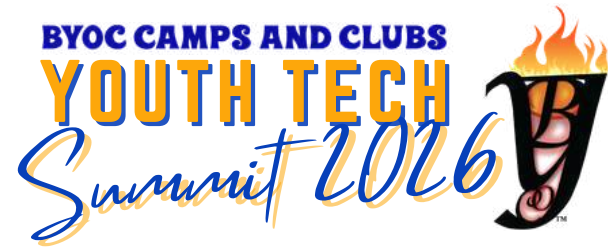

Overall employment in computer and information technology is projected to grow much faster than the average for all occupations between 2023 and 2033.



An average of 356,700 job openings are projected each year in these occupations.

The median annual wage for these occupations was \$104,420 in May 2023, significantly higher than the median annual wage for all occupations.



40% of Black students who enter STEM majors switch out before completing their degrees, highlighting a need for better support and mentorship

Only 20% of U.S. high school graduates are prepared for college-level coursework in STEM majors



This summit aims to address these issues by connecting youth and families with the resources, mentorship, and tools needed to pursue a successful tech career.

By fostering a stronger understanding of tech careers and education paths, we can help more young people, particularly from underrepresented communities, stay on track to succeed in tech.

- David is now writing grants (securing over \$250k) to fund programs for the next generation



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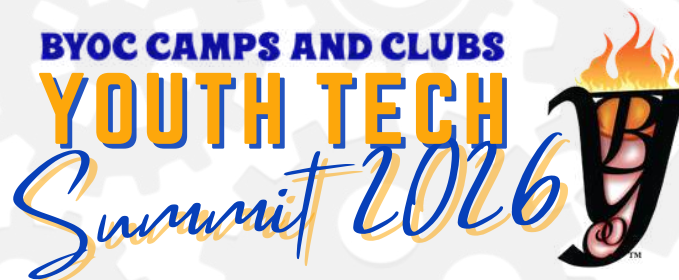
